Silk Road 絲綢之路

Silk Road was a dark web marketplace. Now referred to as a darknet market. It was used as a platform to buy illegal drugs online. In 2013 the FBI shut down the site, which could onle be accesced by a TOR browser; allowed anonymous purchasing. Bitcoin was the missing piece to online drug purachsing puzzle, allowing anonymous payments.

Ross William Ulbricht was arrested and later sentenced to life in prison, without the possibility of parole.
